Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish their price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors.

Attended Funeral: Standard Service (Funeral Director charges only)	
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event and service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	£2730.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements 	£1310.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care 	£260.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Care of the deceased before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased will be kept at our offices in Henley-on-Thames 	£200.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Providing a suitable coffin – this will be an oak effect veneered traditional style coffin 	£330.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Viewing of the deceased for family and friends, by appointment (where viewing is requested by the customer) 	£100.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Taking the deceased direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of our premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle for a service of up to 3 hours 	£530.00

Unattended Funeral – Direct to Crematorium	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Burial (Funeral Director charges only) 	£1550.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cremation (Funeral Director charges plus the cremation fee) ² 	£1560.00

Fees You Must Pay	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For an attended or unattended burial fee ¹ 	£642.00 to £1510.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In our local area the typical cost of a burial fee for local residents is <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cemetery Churchyard 	£1510.00 £840.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For a new grave, you will also need to pay to purchase the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee ² 	£645.00 to £1070.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In our local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents 	£850.00

The Funeral Director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can choose to use a different supplier.

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
